MANAGING FIRE

ALL VESSELS SHOULD HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND SHOULD BE CLOSE AND AVAILABLE DURING REFUELLING. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE ALSO SUPPLIED FOR USE IN EMERGENCIES AND MUST NOT BE REMOVED OR TAMPERED WITH OTHER-WISE, IF YOU NOTICE THESE ARE MISSING OR CAN'T BE FOUND EASILY PLEASE CONTACT WA FUEL SUPPLIES.

- Use the emergency stop button
- Call for help if required
- Use a fire extinguisher and or water hose reel if it is safe to do so
- Pull the pin
 Aim at the base of the fire
 Squeeze the trigger
 Sweep across the base of the fire side to side
- Do not use water on a petroleum or electrical fire
- Keep the fire extinguisher with you until the fire service ar-rives
- Evacuate everyone on site to a safe point.
- Remember to: Stay between the fire and your escape route. Stay low to reduce the effects of smoke. Keep using the fire extinguisher until the fire is completely out. Remain alert until the fire brigade arrives, as the fire may restart due to heat.
